AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ORINDA HORSE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is ORINDA HORSE ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit mutual benefit corporation organized under the Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law. The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity, other than the credit union business, for which a corporation may be organized under such law.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to operate a horse club for the exclusive use and enjoyment of members.

ARTICLE III

- A. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for pleasure, recreation, and other nonprofitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). This corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that do not further the purposes of this corporation.
- B. This corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.

ARTICLE IV

The authorized number and qualifications of the members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, the voting and other rights and privileges of members, and the obligations of members shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

This corporation elects to be governed by all provisions of the Nonprofit Corporation Law not otherwise applicable to it under Part 5 of Division 2.
